FINLAND:

- Veterinary passport.
- Microchip.
- Rabies vaccination at least 21 days before traveling. If it is done before the expiration date of the previous one it won't be necessary to wait.
- Worming tablet: Within 30 days before traveling. It's recommended to repeat the treatment 30 days later.
- Clinical examination signed in the passport

Norway:

- Veterinary passport.
- Microchip.
- Rabies vaccination at least 21 days before traveling. If it is done before the expiration date of the previous one it won't be necessary to wait.
- Worming tablet: 10 days before getting to Norway and during the first week after getting there.
- Clinical examination signed in the passport

UNITED KINGDOM:

- Veterinary passport.
- Microchip.
- Rabies vaccination at least 21 days before traveling. If it is done before the expiration date of the previous one it won't be necessary to wait.
- Worming tablet: within 24-120 hours before getting to the UK.
- Clinical examination signed in the passport

OTHER EUROPEAN UNION COUNTRIES:

- Veterinary passport.
- Microchip.
- Rabies vaccination at least 21 days before traveling. If it is done before the expiration date of the previous one it won't be necessary to wait.
- Clinical examination signed in the passport

COUNTRIES OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION (THIRD COUNTRIES):

- Veterinary passport.
- Microchip.
- Consult the embassy or consulate of the destination country: import requirements for pets are set by the receiving country.
- Animal health certificate: it has to meet all the requirements of the destination country. Usually it's valid during 10 days unless the receiving country indicates otherwise.
- Official Export Certificate: it has to be obtained in the Border Inspection Post (PIF in spanish) office. It is necessary to present the animal health certificate issued by a veterinary surgeon; this same vet would get an appointment for the owner to perform this procedure.
